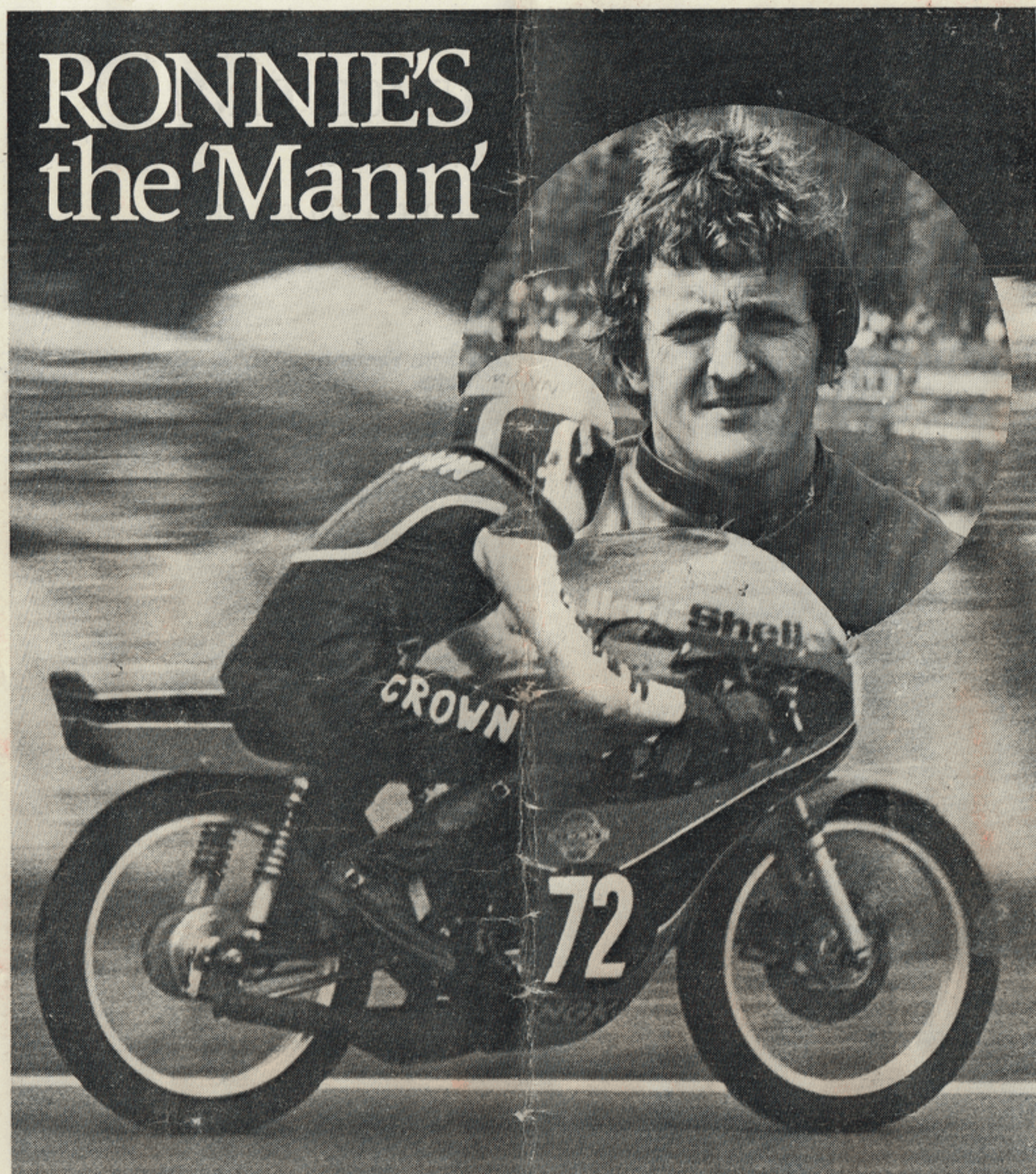

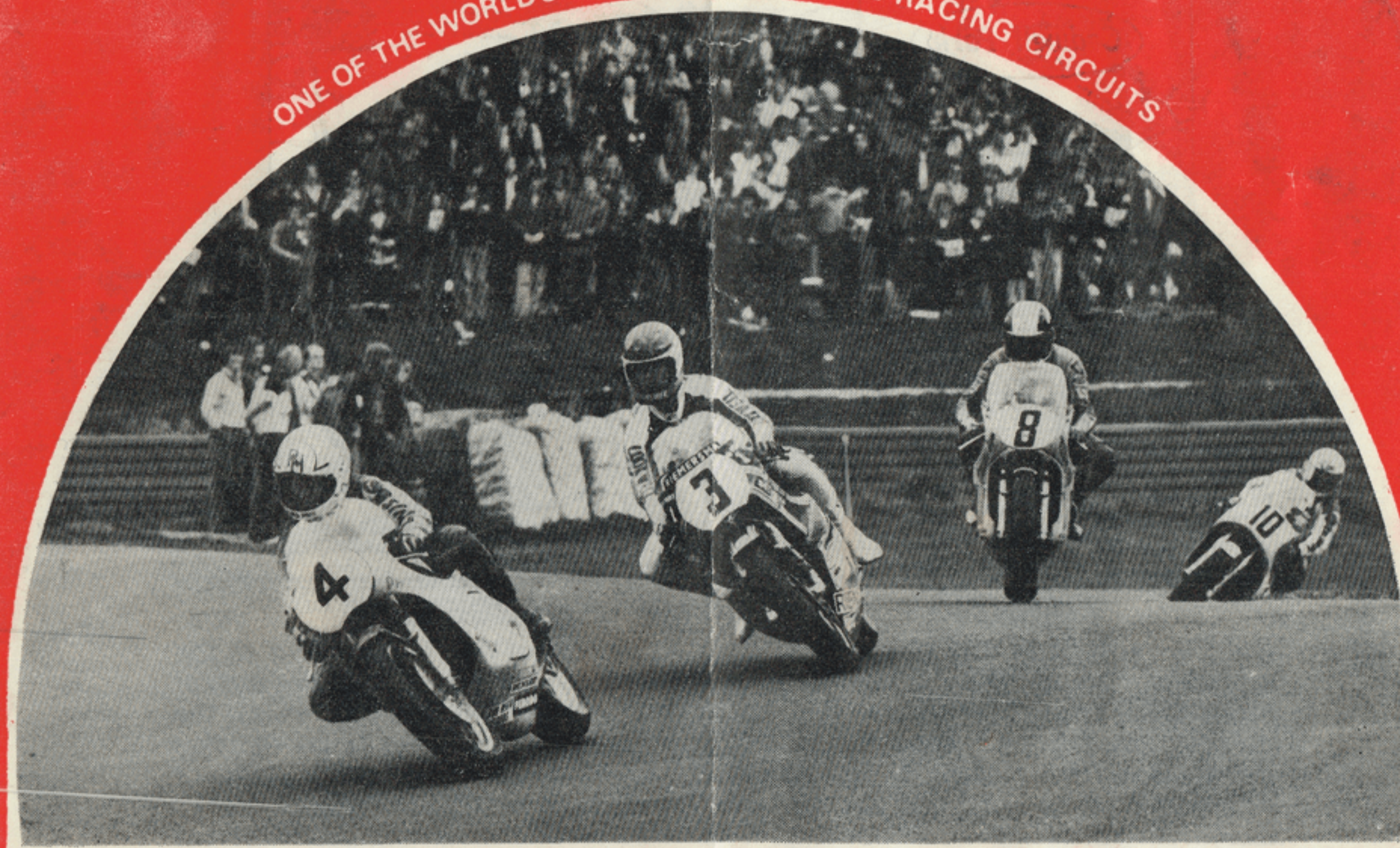

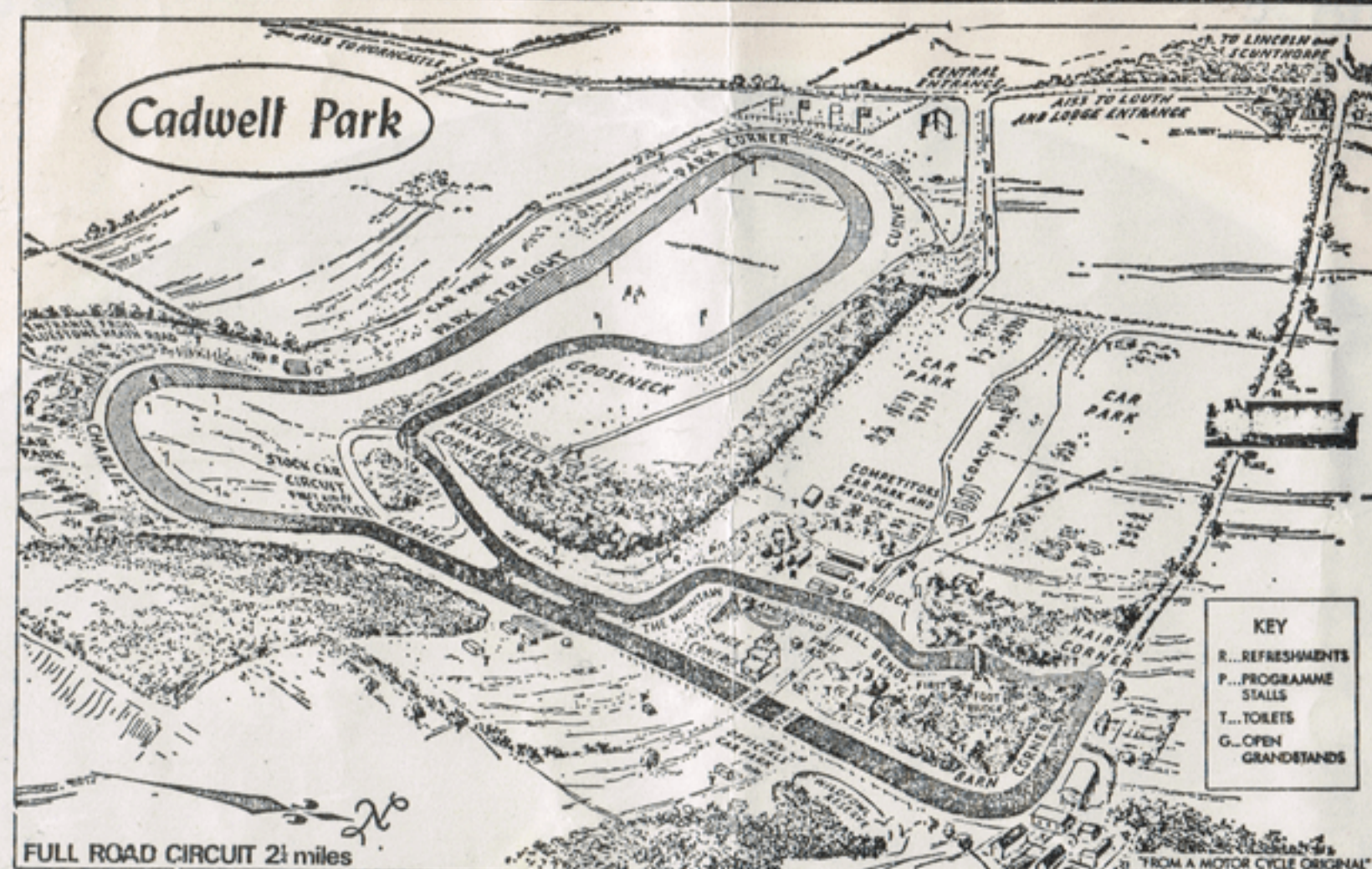

With a superb entry of top talent, today's programme could well be the best held at this demanding circuit for a long time.

On form, Dutch Champion Wil Hartog will be remembered for his battle at Silverstone last month, seen by millions on T.V., when Barry Sheene and Roberts were kept at bay for a great part of the Grand Prix. Also on form is our favourite 'Rocket' Ronnie Haslam, as are several others in one or more of the selected Finals today.

We have the usual top selection of sidecar experts — Dick Greaseley, joint 2nd in this year's World Championship and now leading the MCW/Forward Trust Championship — has a battle ahead with Stu Pearson who, last month, broke the circuit lap record, a favourite at Cadwell, plus the dashing Jock Taylor, Mick Boddice, Gordon Nottingham & co., not forgetting Roine Larsson and Jim Forsstrom who are tops in their native Sweden. Foreign entries are increasingly numerous and competitive ; amongst them Australian Champion Peter Campbell who, despite his handicap, handles his powerful outfit with amazing dexterity.

Just a thought — what will Mal Carter do with the Fruit Machine if Ronnie wins it for him in the 'Appleby Glade' Race today ?!

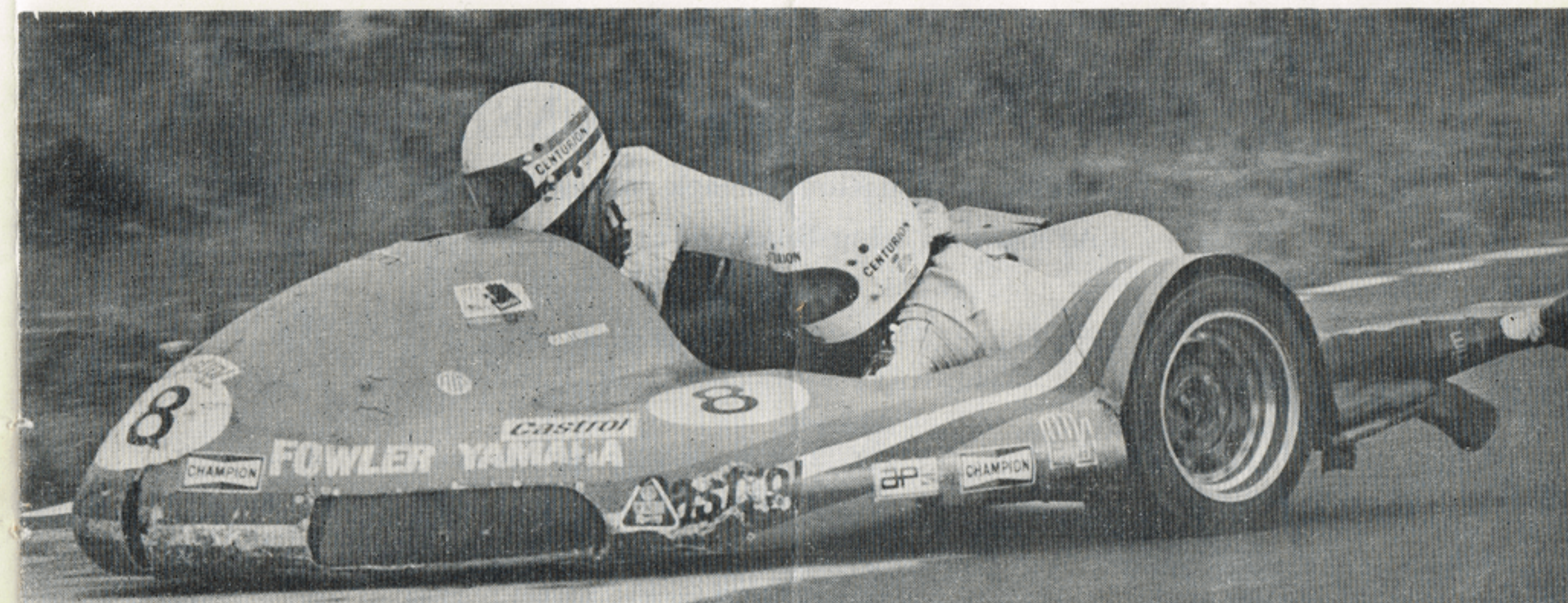
