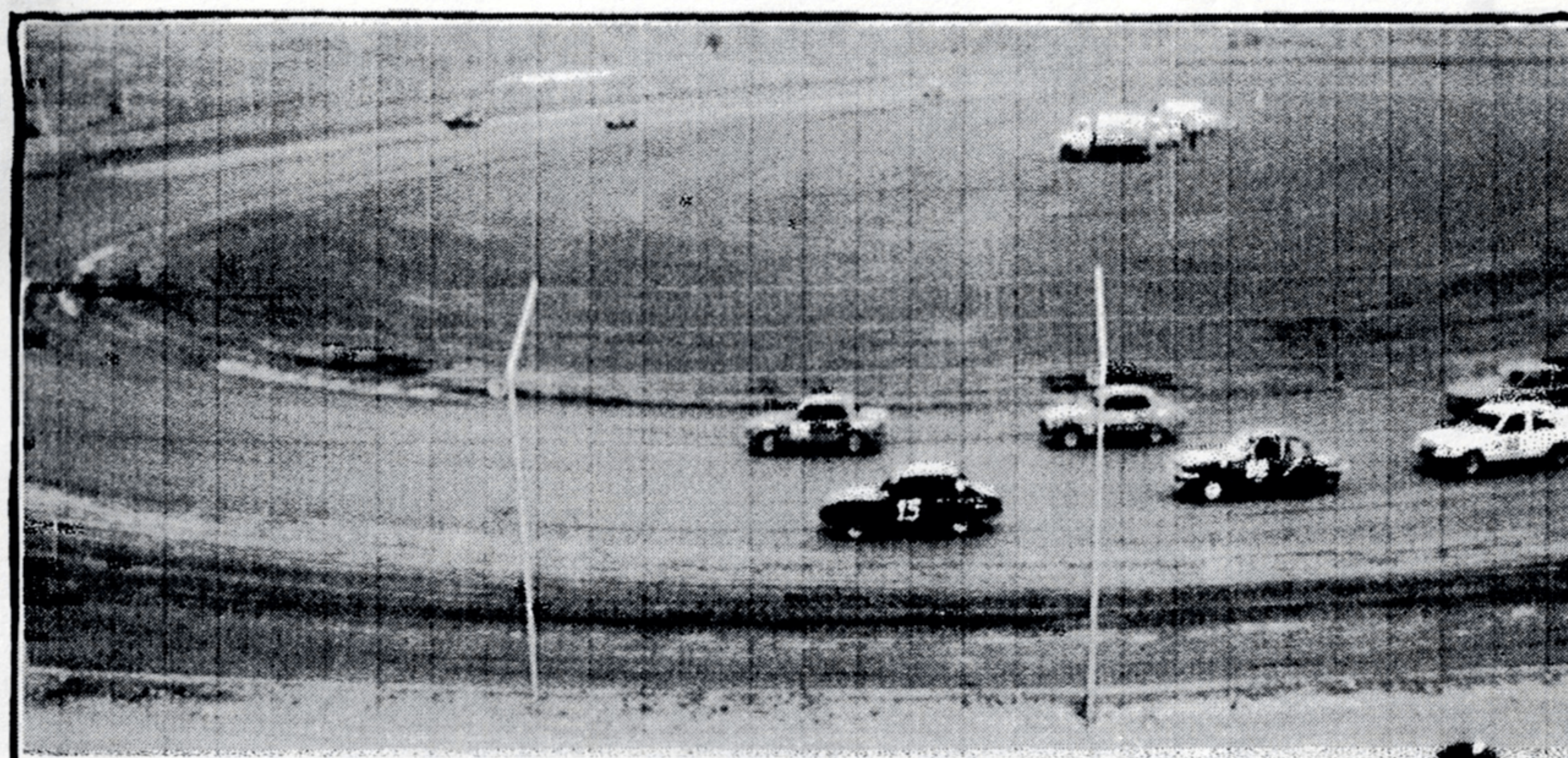

Video & In-Car Review

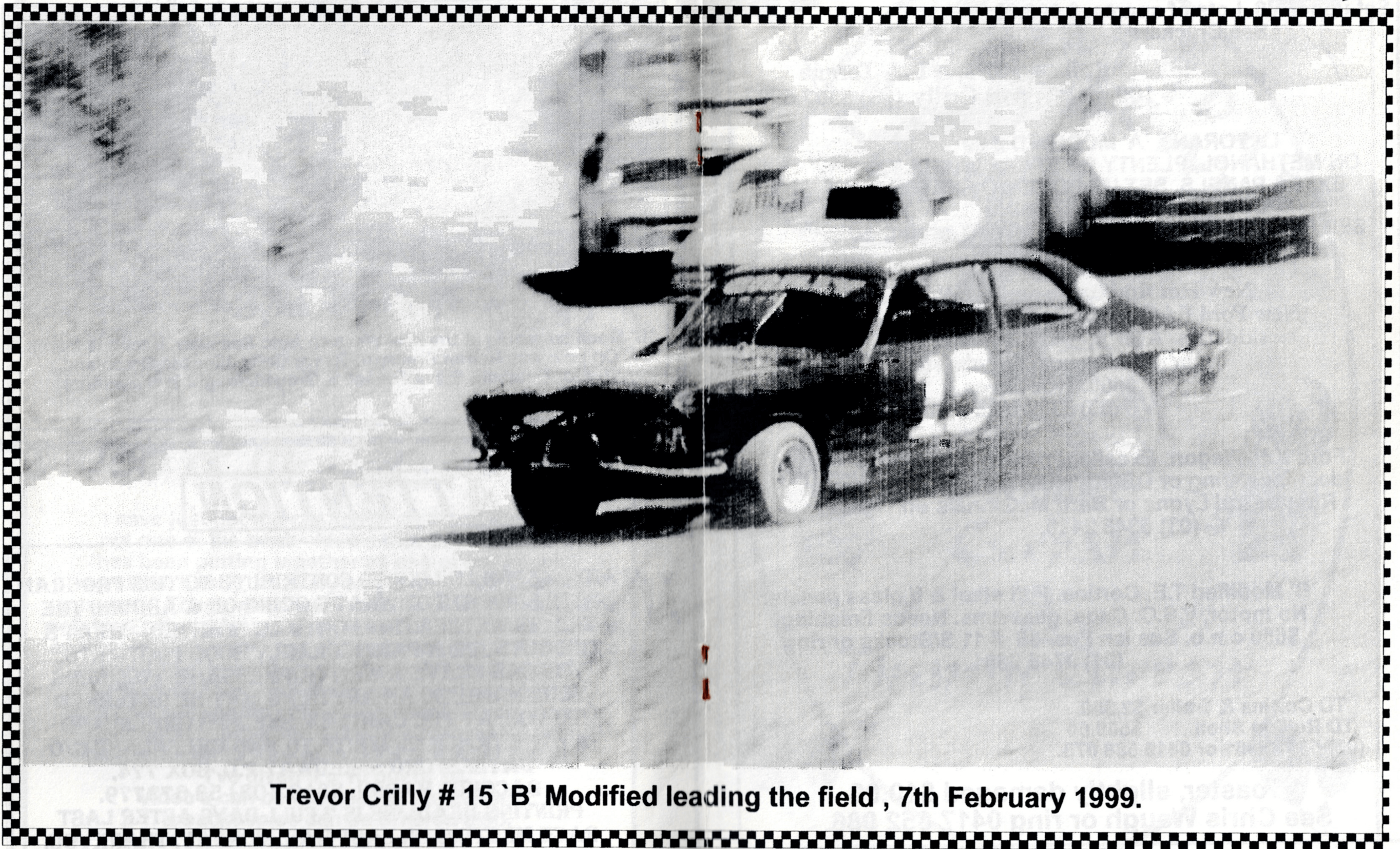
I have just got the chance to sit down & check out one of the track video's that Colin Radburn has been putting together as one of our special services. Firstly, as Molly would say, "Do yourself a favour!" These video's are terrific. One minute you're watching normal racing, then the shot shows the same at another angle. You've got all turns featured & if there's a prang, the video shows you from different angles. I personally think that Colin does a brilliant job at what we once could only guess about. If you haven't seen what it looks like to be in a car when it rolls, then hang on to your hats. This is a great watch & I've given it a 10 out of 10.
